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Twin Falls Chalet – Itinerary

Note: plan may be altered due to trail and weather conditions.

Thursday, July 26

10:30 AM – Meet at Takakkaw Falls parking lot.

Allow 3 hours from Calgary

12:30 PM – Lunch at Laughing Falls

3:30 PM – Arrive at Twin Falls Chalet

8.1 km, 260 meters elevation gain

6:00 PM Dinner

Friday, July 27

8:00 AM – Breakfast, prepare lunches

9:30 AM – Hike to Waterfall Valley

4.6 km, 215 meters elevation gain

6:00 PM – Dinner

Saturday, July 28

8:00 AM – Breakfast, prepare lunches

9:30 AM – Hike out via Iceline Trail

14 km, 500 meters elevation gain

4:30 PM – Arrive back at Takakkaw Falls.

7:30 PM – Arrive back to Calgary
